#### **Action #2 Tony Hill**

Three intrepid Stroud CAMRA members attended the CAMRA West Central Club of the year presentation at Cheltenham Motor Club and extended the outing to a mini pub crawl in Cheltenham on the way back to the bus on the Promenade. Tim Mars gave the account highlighting the very different venues:

**Cheltenham Motor Club:** the purpose of the visit, great atmosphere and a good range of beers. The landlord had been given a German wooden cask ale that he was providing in half's free to those that wanted to try it. The flavours were complex, the beer morish.

**Sandford Park Alehouse:** a well-known venue with a good range of Keg and Cask Ales. We were lucky enough to enjoy the outdoor space in very pleasant weather.

**Strand:** close by Sandford Park Alehouse on the same side of the road. A greater focus on keg beer. An outdoor space marred by intrusive piped music.

**Planet Caravan:** this is a keg only bar and we had to drag Tim in kicking and screaming. Of particular note to him was the logo on the beer mats. Chris and Tony enjoyed a Swedish beer, A Decade of Pastry - Noa Anniversary Stout - Imperial / Double Pastry @ 14.2% ABV.

**Old Courthouse:** the USP of this establishment is the unchanged aspects of the former courthouse upstairs. In the basement the cells have been repurposed as toilets and wine stores. Three reputable real ales available.

All in all, an enjoyable jaunt.

With Oktoberfest just around the corner Stroud Brewery has not one, but two new brews coming your way...🍺🍺

Dark Skies is now available on draught in the Taproom & online in cans. Stroud describe it thus:

*Brewed in the depths of winter under dark skies, this rich and complex beer has been aged in oak whisky barrels to develop its unique character. Oak, time, and char each lend their own distinct touch, layering depth and nuance. Expect notes of molasses, liquorice, and dark dried fruits, all finishing with a mellow whisky heat.*

It carries a punch at 8% ABV though I had to look this up on Untapped as the Brewery description does not give it.

At the time of these minutes Stroud CAMRA were unable to determine what the second beer was.
